The Studio at BAC Stages Sixth Annual Performing Arts Showcase

This year's teaching artists are: Blast Off Performing Arts improv troupe, musicians Charles Baumgartner and Chris Kahl, as well as dancers Destinee Rhodes and Alicia Robin.

"The Showcase isn't just about performing," said Arts Program Manager, Lee Sorensen. "Learning the routines helps our artists with disabilities stay focused, increases their cognitive skills and improves self-esteem. Plus, for many, the Showcase is the only opportunity they will ever get to perform on stage."
